Step 5: Sign the Chapter Agreement

Submit your finalized plan and sign the Chapter Agreement, which outlines basic expectations and how your chapter can operate independently while staying connected to the Consortium brand and standards.

Step 6: Launch Your Chapter

Announce your chapter, host your first meeting or event, and begin engaging healthcare leaders in your region. You'll have the flexibility to lead your chapter in a way that best suits your community's needs, with light-touch support from our national team when needed.
